Learn About "Making Strategy Real" from the Center for Creative Leadership

In this edition of the *Wire*, we're pleased to share with all WICT members some of the content that the Center for Creative Leadership (CCL) will use as the basis for the 2011 [Betsy Magness Graduate Institute](#).

The desire to be more strategic is a common goal of leaders. So what does it mean to be more strategic? CCL defines it as follows: individuals, teams, and organizations are strategic when they think, act and influence in ways that effectively promote the organization's

enduring success. To be successful, a leader engages others by helping them cross boundaries and get out of silos to discover new opportunities and innovative solutions.

In *Making Strategy Real: Bringing People Together Toward a Common Cause*, CCL advises leaders to focus on "clear priorities, creating common understanding through real dialogue, and engendering a learning orientation in the organization."

Leaders quickly discover that this is often easier said than done. "Picture a massive and complex game of tug-of-war with no overarching goal: people work passionately to achieve their own goals but pull in different directions. It's hard for the whole organization to move forward under such circumstances.

"So a key task of strategic leaders is to set clear priorities. But the real challenge for the top team and the organization lies in following through. In the end, do people have a common understanding of the priorities? Are the priorities communicated in consistent ways throughout the organization? Is everyone really on the same page?"

Setting clear priorities and defining strategies are key tasks required of leaders, however, the real challenge lies in following through to ensure complete understanding and buy-in by the entire team, as well as defining the metrics that determine success. "Formulating strategy is not an event followed by implementation. It is a learning process, much like the scientific process of hypothesis testing. Leaders, ideally with input from stakeholders, formulate theories about what it will take for the organization to be successful in its particular environment; they then test their theories using, in effect, business experiments in which they implement tactics arising from those theories. Through these experiments everyone in the organization learns about what is and is not working, and the leaders use that new information to amend their theories of the business."

The Women in Technology Award, sponsored by **Bright House Networks**, was created in 1995 to recognize and honor leading technology professionals. The award annually acknowledges the achievements of one woman who has demonstrated outstanding personal and professional growth and significantly contributed to the cable telecommunications industry.

A long-time member of WICT and SCTE, Susan is a graduate of Class 19 of WICT's prestigious Betsy Magness Leadership Institute. In 2008 she was named to *CableFax's* "Most Powerful Women in Cable" list, and in 2010 was named one of the "Top Women in Cable Tech" for that same publication.

The 2010 winner, **Leslie Ellis**, an independent technology consultant and analyst, will present the 2011 Women in Technology Award during SCTE Cable-Tec Expo®, November 15-17, during Cable Connection Fall in Atlanta.
