WOMEN IN CABLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS VIRGINIA CHAPTER

Whistleblower Policy

- Repor ng Responsibility. It is the responsibility of WOMEN IN CABLE
 TELECOMMUNICATIONS VIRGINIA CHAPTER (WICT VA) volunteer leaders to report
 viola ons or suspected viola ons of the law or WICT VA policy in all opera ons,
 including, but not limited to, accoun ng prac ces, internal controls and audi ng,
 pursuant to this Whistleblower Policy.
- 2. <u>No Retalia on.</u> No person who in good faith reports a viola on shall su er harassment, rela on or adverse consequence. A volunteer leader who retaliates against someone who has reported a viola on in good faith is subject to discipline up to and including termina on of chapter volunteer leadership. This Whistleblower Policy is intended to encourage and enable volunteer leaders and others to raise serious concerns within the organiza on prior to seeking resolu on outside the organiza on.
- 3. Repor ng Viola ons. Volunteer leaders should share their ques ons, concerns, sugges ons or complaints with someone who can address them properly. In most cases, a chapter president is in the best posi on to address an area of concern. However, if a volunteer leader is not comfortable speaking with a chapter president or not sa s ed with a chapter president's response, the volunteer leader is encouraged to speak with the Vice President (VP) of Membership & Chapter Development at WICT Na onal, who has specil cland exclusive responsibility to investigate all reported viola ons. For suspected fraud, or if a volunteer leader is not salse all reported with the following organiza on's open door policy, volunteer leaders should contact the VP of Membership & Chapter Development directly.
- 4. <u>VP of Membership & Chapter Development.</u> The organiza on's VP of Membership & Chapter Development is responsible for inves ga ng and resolving all reported complaints and allega ons and shall advise the chapter advisor concerning such proceedings. If the chapter advisor is being reported, the VP of Membership & Chapter

Development is responsible for advising the chapter president and ensuring the right chain of command is followed up to and including the WICT President and CEO.

- 5. <u>Ac ng in Good Faith.</u> Anyone ling a complaint concerning a viola on or suspected viola on under this Whistleblower Policy must be ac ng in good faith and have reasonable grounds for believing the informa on disclosed indicates a viola on. Any allega ons that prove not to be substan ated and which prove to have been made maliciously or with knowledge that they are false will be viewed as a serious disciplinary o ense.
- 6. <u>Con den ality.</u> Viola ons or suspected viola ons may be submi ed on a con den al basis by the complainant or may be submi ed anonymously. Reports of viola ons will be kept con den al to the extent possible, consistent with the need to conduct an adequate inves ga on.
- 7. <u>Handling of Reported Viola ons.</u> The VP of Membership & Chapter Development will no fy the sender and acknowledge receipt of the reported viola on or suspected viola on within a reasonable amount of me. All reports will be promptly inves gated and appropriate corrective action will be taken if warranted by the investigation.

WOMEN IN CABLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS VIRGINIA CHAPTER

Con ict of Interest Policy

- 1. Policy Statement. Each o cer, director, and commi ee or task force member (volunteer leader) should avoid both actual and apparent con icts of interest that would interfere with their ability to discharge their duciary responsibilities to WOMEN IN CABLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS VIRGINIA CHAPTER (WICT VA). WICT VA encourages its volunteer leaders to follow ethical standards, to be in compliance with all laws, and to avoid any condict of interest, or appearance of such, including having their tles or a diagon on used to publicize personal or company activities, programs, or events (especially those conducted for private protein). Each volunteer leader is required to disclose annually their interests that could give rise to a condict of interest.
- 2. <u>Con ict of Interest De ned.</u> The term con ict of interest includes, but is not limited to, circumstances where a volunteer leader, or a member of his or her immediate family:
 - (a) owns any nancial or other proprietary interest in any entry supplying (or seeking to supply) goods or services to WICT;
 - (b) accepts, agrees to accept or solicits any substan all bene t from a third party on account of that party's past, present, or future business relai onship with WICT;
 - (c) receives any substan al nancial bene t from a pending decision of WICT or from an organiza on or individual being evaluated by WICT; or
 - (d) serves as an o cer, director or commi ee member of any compe ng organiza on, i.e., any nonpro t or business enterprise whose purposes, products, and/or services compete with those of WICT.
- 3. <u>Disclosure of the Existence of a Con_ict.</u> If any volunteer leader of WICT knows, believes, or has reason to know or believe, that he/she has a con_ict of interest or a poten al con_ict of interest with respect to any transac_on involving WICT, any decision of the Board, any decision of a commi_ee or task force, or any ac_on taken by an o_cer

(transac on), such person shall inform the Board of the Commi ee of the existence of such conject of interest or poten all conject of interest.

- 4. <u>E ect of the Existence of a Con ict of Interest.</u> In the event that it is determined that a con ict of interest exists, and the volunteer leader has made full disclosure of the facts surrounding the con ict, then the Board of Directors shall determine whether the volunteer leader may fully par cipate in the delibera ons and vote on the a ected transac on. If the volunteer leader merely discloses the existence of the con ict of interest or poten al con ict of interest, yet fails to disclose or is prohibited from disclosing all material facts regarding the con ict, then such volunteer leader shall be prohibited in par cipa ng in any manner or form in the delibera ons or decisions regarding the a ected transac on.
- 5. Resigna on. No individual who has an actual con ict of interest shall be required to resign his or her posi on with WICT VA merely because of the existence of a con ict; however, the remaining members of the Board of Directors may make a fair and full evalua on of all facts pertaining to the con ict of interest to determine its extent. If the remaining members of the Board of Directors make a determina on in wring that the nature and extent of the conict of interest is so substantal and of such a connuing nature that it would be impossible for the volunteer leader to discharge the dues of his or her once with the requisite degree of loyalty and integrity, then the Board of Directors may require the resignation on of the volunteer leader who is subject to the conict of interest or secure removal of the volunteer leader as permital ed by law.
